Safety Pledge

I will perform all my activities in a professional and safe manner, and will hold myself accountable for my actions in all of our Missions for America.

I'M SAFE Review

- ✓ I – Illness
- ✓ M – Medication
- ✓ S – Stress
- ✓ A—Alcohol
- ✓ F – Fatigue
- ✓ E -- Emotion

If for any reason one or more of these items affects you, you have a responsibility to yourself and everyone at this event to report it to a staff member. The situation will be assessed at that time for corrective action, reassignment or dismissal. There is no shame involved and there will be no repercussions for reporting any effects.

Knock it Off Policy in effect at all times in all phases of the operation

- ✓ All CAP personnel are accountable for their actions, both on and off duty.
- ✓ Know the established procedures and follow them. If a situation exists that is not specifically addressed, I expect mature judgment to be exercised.
- ✓ Correct and/or report all safety hazards as soon as they are discovered. Effective communication is key.
- ✓ Anyone can call a "knock it off" when an unsafe situation develops, and no reprisals will ever be taken against someone raising a safety concern. Be assertive in challenging unsafe practices.

Do not be intimidated by rank, position or any other factor. Everyone has an equal responsibility to the safe operation. If you must question if an action or procedure is safe, then it probably is not and the operation should be halted immediately.

2016 MER SAR COLLEGE – BLACKSTONE TOWER/ ADVISORY RADIO

NOTE WELL: *Blackstone Tower* will be operational on 126.2 for the majority of our time at BKT. When the tower is operational, you are in controlled airspace and on a controlled field. *Blackstone Advisory* consists of CAP members helping to monitor pattern traffic on the CTAF frequency of 126.2 (PCL 122.95). *Blackstone Advisory* will be able to give aircraft updates much like UNICOM but will not be “clearing” aircraft to taxi, take off, or land. When *Blackstone Tower* is **not** operational, our field at BKT is an uncontrolled field and it is essential that aircraft make required radio calls in the pattern. Tower phone: 434-292-2047
